2021 ENROLMENT - Important Information

We want to ensure that your child thrives at intermediate school and feels as if Mt Roskill Intermediate is home. - 02 September Out-of-Zone Enrolments Application closing date
- 09 September Out-of-Zone Ballot date
- 11 September Ballot result and Acceptance of Enrolment is communicated by email
- 25 September Those successful in the Ballot are asked to confirm acceptance of their place

In-Zone

- 02 September In-Zone Enrolment. We appreciate receiving these by this date to allow the school plenty of time to plan for the following year.

Transition Visits

We hold transition visits for enrolled students who will spend half a day at MRI in Year 7 classrooms. These include an orientation, time in a specialist classroom and getting to know other students and staff.

- 29 October All other Primary Schools Transition visit

Staff Visits

In Weeks 5-7 of Term 4, our staff visit the main contributing primary schools to gather the Year 6 information required for your child's smooth transition to our school and their class placement.
